Process (CAP) for all the programmes Applicants are therefore, directed to apply to the University by online and seek admission through the admission process. Those desirous of getting admission in the management quota should fulfill initial centralized admission process and then submit separate application form to the college for completing management admission process.

The selected candidates should submit their certificates to college authorities for scrutinising and finalisation of admission process. The selected candidates under CAP, therefore, submit the following documents at the time of admission.

- 2. Qualifying Certificates
- 3. Transfer Certificate from the institution last attended.
- 4. Conduct Certificate from the institution last attended
- 5. Four copies of Passport Size Photos, one stamp size and CD of Passport size photo.

Uniform Rules

- 1. Uniform is compulsory for all students
- Students are expected to respect the college uniform and are compulsorily required to attend the classes, wearing proper uniform on all working days, for all occasions, functions, special classes, and revision classes.
- 3. Students are not permitted to make alterations, additions, or omissions to the uniform
- 4. Uniform material should not bear any self designs on them
- 5. The Colour, complexion of the uniform material and stitching instructions and other rules related to uniform will be given at the time of admission.

Ragging is prohibited in the Campus

Ragging is prohibited in the campus. Students are warned that as per provisions of the Kerala prohibition of ragging Act 1998 and order of Calicut University, ragging within or outside the college is strictly prohibited.

If any student is found guilty on the parameters of the law of ragging, he/she shall be punished for 2 years imprisonment along with fine. Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 of the act shall be dismissed from the institution and such students shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of three years from the date of order of such dismissal.
