In this academic year committee conducted three audit course examinations for first semester (Environmental Studies), third semester (Human Rights) and fourth semester (Gender Studies).

Committee have formulated brief syllabus for the Certificate Courses provided under the department. It was decided to provide the course titled Political Journalism for second year Conflict Resolution for first year classes. Detailed guidelines were issued by the committee for the conduct of certificate courses. It

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## 1. ACADEMIC MONITORING

Department of Political Science faculties conducted online classes, due to severe Covid-19 spreading, according to the university syllabus and covered it timely. All the faculties cover the portions or topic within the stipulated time limit. It was decided by the department of Political science to complete the portion ten days before the end date of that semester. Two internal examinations are conducted for each semester. This help the students to progress their academic qualities and teachers can help the students in their weaker points.

- Result Analysis: University External Examination results are analyzed after every external examination.
- Action taken for time-bound semester plan coverage.
- Faculties of the department complete their syllabus as per the semester plan within the time limit. Study materials were given properly by each faculty immediately after the classes. Each faculty conduct seminar by providing topics to each students. After completion of all these things a doubt clearance session has conducted by each faculty. The slow learners were given special care and special sessions are conducted to nurture the learning skills and abilities of the slow learners. Whenever a faculty member is on leave, students will engage themselves with group discussion and supplemental learning.

## 3) Advanced and Slow Learners-Centric Classes:

Identification and support initiatives for slow and advanced learners in the department of Political Science at Kottakkal Farook Arts and Science College for academic year 2020-2021:

The Department of Political Science followed a comprehensive process to identify Slow and Advanced Learners among the students. The assessment criteria included an objective test based on the Higher Secondary syllabus and bridge



  
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classes (weightage 50%), the students' academic performance in preceding higher secondary board examination (weightage 25%) and class room observation by subject teachers (weightage 25%). Students securing mark below 40% were identified as slow learners, while those scoring above 70% were identified as advanced learners.

For slow learners, the department conducted various support activities throughout the semesters

1. Remedial classes and coaching sessions were organized online and offline, including on weekend and during vacations, to provide additional support and reinforce key concepts.
2. Previous year question papers, question banks and practice sessions were provided to help slow learners prepare for exams and enhance their comprehension.
3. Individual attention, counseling sessions, and supplementary study materials were offered to address the specific learning need of slow learners.

For advanced learners, the department conducted various support activities throughout the semesters were implemented:



  
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1. Motivation and recognition programmes, such as Semester topper awards and opportunities to mentor their peers, were organized to acknowledge their excellence and foster a culture of mutual motivation
2. Academic enrich activities, including challenging assignments, encouragement to pursue NPTEL and advanced courses, and participation in seminars, conference's, and technical event, were provided to stimulate their learning and broaden their academic experience.
3. Career guidance workshops, Project based learning with faculty mentorship, and industry partnership through memorandums of understandings (MoUs) were facilitated to support advanced learners in their career planning and practical skill development.

The implementation of this initiative resulted in positive outcomes including improved performance and reduced arrears for Slow Learners, as well as increased participation in academic events and enhanced career prospects for Advanced Learners. The department maintained records documentation of these activities, including attendance records, performance, improvement reports, and list of tasks.



  
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## DOCUMENTATION OF ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Documentation serves a vital tool for assessing and evaluating the quality and effectiveness of academic programmes and institutions. It provides a comprehensive record of various activities such as curriculum development, teaching methodologies, assessment strategies, research endeavors, and students' achievements. ### UPKEEP OF TEACHERS DIARY

Every faculty member in the political science department has diligently maintained their respective teacher's diary up-to-date. This ensures that a comprehensive and accurate record of their academic and administrative activities is available for assessment and improvement purposes. They regularly update their lesson plans, outlining the Curriculum Content, teaching methodology, and assessment strategies. They also record their assigned duties and responsibilities, including committees memberships,



  
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administrative tasks, and extracurricular activities. This promotes transparency and accountability in the department's functioning.

### **CLASS ADJUSTMENT DURING FACULTY LEAVE**

Students are effectively engaged and continued their learning during the absence of regular faculty members. The department adopted comprehensive approach that involved engaging students with other qualified faculty members. Highly competent and experienced substitute faculties were assigned to conduct the classes during the leave period. Additionally, students made frequent visits to the department's bookshelves, taking advantage of the diverse collection of political science literatures and reference materials.

### **STUDENT ATTENDANCE MONITORING AND MENTORING BY ADVISORS**

The Political science has implemented an efficient class monitoring system that involves regular assessment, class observations and feedback sessions to gauge student progress. The system ensures that student performance is closely monitored and appropriate interventions are made when necessary.

- The mentoring programme in the political science department place a crucial role in providing personalized guidance and support to



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students. Each advisor is assigned a group of students to mentor throughout the academic year. The mentors actively engage with their mentees, discussing their academic goals strengths and areas of improvement

- The Political science department keeps a comprehensive record of levels taken by students to monitor their attendance and identified patterns that may affect their academic performance. Early intervention measures are taken when students show a consistent pattern of absenteeism
- Regular communication with parents is key aspect of the mentoring programme. Advisors regularly update parents on their child's progress, areas for improvement and overall wellbeing. This collaborative approach fosters a strong support system for students, leading to improved learning outcomes.

## SUPPLEMENTAL LEARNING

Political Science department implemented supplemental learning systems to provide additional support and enrichment to students. There are two essential components of the systems: Peer Tutoring and the role of advanced learners in facilitating supplemental learning. This initiatives aim to foster the role advanced



  
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learners in facilitating supplemental learning. The initiatives aim to foster a conducive learning environment that caters to the diverse needs of the students and promote collaborative learning within the department.

**Peer Tutoring:** The political Science department has established a peer tutoring programme to enable students to receive academic assistance from their peers who excel in specific subject or skill. Peer tutors are carefully selected based on their academic achievements, communication skills and willingness to help others. The peer tutoring sessions provide one-on-one or small group support to struggling student, enabling them to overcome challenge and improve their understanding of course material.

For organizing supplemental learning, five peer leaders have been selected by Head of the Department for each class. Peer leaders help other students to clear their doubts. By discussions and through friendly talk's students enhance their knowledge easily. Faculty members will also guide the students to improve their team activity.

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## 1. MENTORING FOR STUDENTS

Mentoring has been a necessity to resolve problems relating to academics and other related issues faced by students. It is required for the students to achieve emotional stability and to promote clarity in thinking and decision – making for overall programme. Each teacher is assigned certain number of students for mentoring. They meet at regular interval to discuss, clarify and share various problems which may be personal, domestic and academic. The Mentoring can build healthy relationship between the students and teachers in building their discipline, Performance and also positive growth of the students.

The students were continuously mentored regarding their academics. They were motivated and continuously encouraged to seek help from teachers for the subjects in which are weak. Mentors encouraged students to participate in all co-curricular and inter-class events to help them develop confidence. After each internal the students of each mentor take notes of their progress in their learning and prepare them better for the end semester examinations.
